

Directions to Vital Communities

Vital Communities is located on the second floor of the Amtrak Station in downtown White River Jct.

Traveling South on I-91:

- Take I-91 South to Exit 11, White River Junction.
- At the bottom of the ramp, go Left onto Rt. 5 South.
- Cross under I-91 and you will be at a traffic light with McDonald's on your right.

Traveling North on I-91:

- Take I-91 North to Exit 11, for White River Junction (just north of the intersection with I-89).
- Follow the exit ramp as it merges with Rt. 5 South until you reach a traffic light. McDonald's will be on your right.

Traveling South on I-89:

- Take 89 South to the exit for I-91, which is just past Exit 1 (Quechee/Woodstock) and just before the NH border/Connecticut River.
- On the exit ramp, bear left for I-91 North.
- Stay in the right lane as you merge onto 91 North; you'll immediately exit again to White River Jct. (exit 11)
- Follow the exit ramp as it merges with Rt. 5 North until you reach a traffic light. McDonald's will be on your right.

Traveling North on I-89:

- Take 89 North to the NH/VT border, the Connecticut River. Cross the river into VT and take the first exit, for I-91 North and White River Junction.
- Stay in the right lane as you merge onto 91 North; after 50 feet, take Exit 11 for White River Jct.
- Follow the exit ramp as it merges with Rt. 5 North until you reach a traffic light. McDonald's will be on your right.

THEN....

- Travel straight through the light, down a hill, and straight through one more set of lights into the village of White River Junction.
- At the stop sign, travel straight for one short block, then take a left just past the Polka Dot Diner, and cross the railroad tracks. You will be heading straight toward the Court House.
- At the stop sign, take a right; drive straight into the parking lot next to the Amtrak Station.
- You will see the door for the Vermont Welcome Center; our door is two doors to the left, facing the parking lot, with our sign outside the door. We are on the 2nd floor of the train station, with handicapped access provided by an elevator located just inside the door to the right.

(Note: From the interstate, follow signs to the Vermont Welcome Center.)
